## **DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY**

RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU & 2015/863/EU

Directive 2011/65/EU (Restriction of Hazardous Substances – RoHS 2) of the European Parliament and of the Council, which was extended by Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 – (RoHS 3), serves to restrict the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The use of the following ten substances is restricted to a maximum concentration of 0.1 %:

- 1. Lead (Pb)
- 2. Mercury (Hg)
- 3. Cadmium (Cd)
- 4. Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
- 5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- 6. Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
- 7. Di (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- 8. Butylbenzyl phthalate (BBP)
- 9. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- 10. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

We hereby confirm, to the best of our knowledge and belief based on the information provided by our suppliers, that the products distributed by us are compliant with the above regulation and extension.

Exemptions apply to some special items which contain lead as an alloying element in steel, in aluminium and in copper alloys - in an industry-standard manner - listed in Annex III of Directive 2011/65/EU. Some products may contain a mass concentration of over 0.1 % (max. 4 %). The values are according to the regulation - refer to Annex III 6(a), 6(b), 6(c). The lead it contains does not pose a health risk when used as intended.

If changes to the above-mentioned regulation result in new requirements for our products, we will implement them. If we become aware of limit values being exceeded, we will forward the information immediately.
